Execujet's upgraded terminal features a relaxed but refined lobby that pairs island-inspired comfort with modern sophistication. Execujet's build emphasizes functional design and convenience, featuring a ramped walkway that connects the main lobby to the only exclusive vehicle parking area on the airfield, the release makes known.

Safety and sustainability were also top priorities in the development. The property includes 24-hour police and video surveillance and operates partially on solar-sourced energy.

The FBO's airside design allows for direct apron access, accommodating aircraft of all sizes, GPU hook-ups, and passenger drop-off zones. Located beside the airport's 7,000-foot runway, Execujet's terminal is strategically positioned for efficiency and speed, offering operators a premium location for quick turns and standby AOG support.

Based in Charlotte Amalie, the terminal is located within 30 minutes of the island's premier dining, shopping, yachting, and sailing attractions.
