
Mr. Pete's Playhouse, Started During Pandemic, Now Bringing Joy to Children All Over

Mr. Pete's Playhouse has produced over 50 episodes and have expanded to producing live performances, and a catalog of original songs available on streaming platforms such as Spotify and Apple Music.

Julio is also currently working on a children's book series called "The Adventures of Khari" with the first book "Khari Goes to the Fair" scheduled to be released in May 2022.
