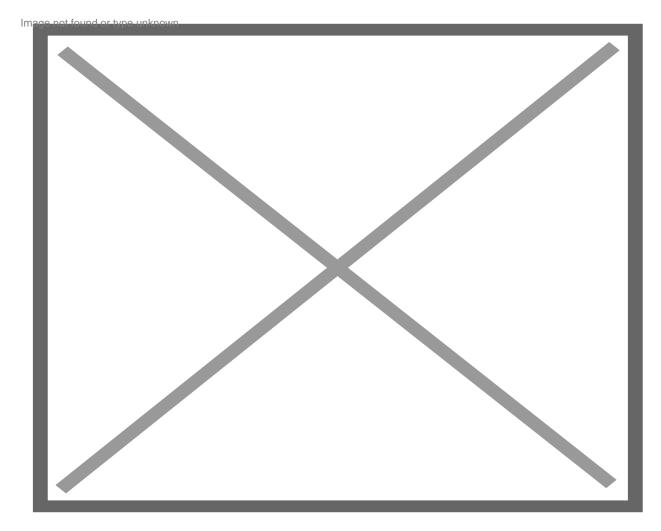
Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority to Host Inaugural 'Stroll the Runway' Fundraiser in St. Croix
