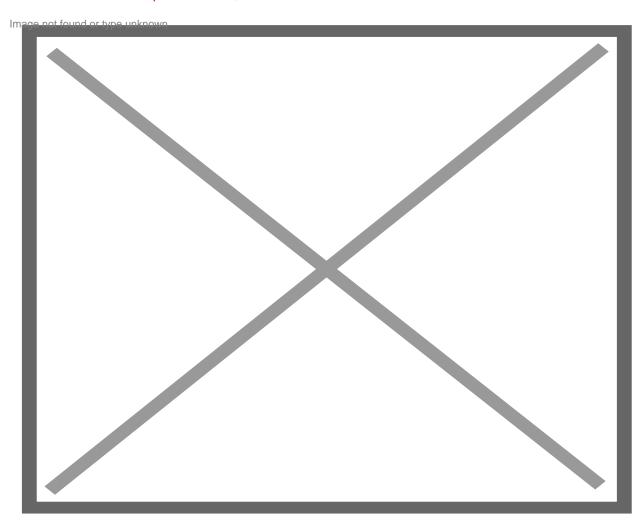
St. Thomas Awaits Over 300 Attendees for the Caribbean Hotel Investment Conference and Operations Summit

The conference venue, the newly opened Westin Beach Resort & Spa at Frenchman's Reef, underwent a remarkable \$425 million rebuild and encapsulates the sophistication and service associated with the Westin brand, tinged with a distinctive U.S. Virgin Islands charm.
