During the period of closure, Curleen Rogers, director of the Abattoir, prioritized machinery maintenance and parts replacement, according to release DOA issued.

“I would like to extend my deep appreciation to Mr. Greenidge who led the efforts in reopening the abattoir, and our hardworking staff, without whom we would have no abattoir,” said Agriculture Commissioner Nominee Louis Petersen.
