The V.I. Division of Personnel together with the GESC Health Insurance Board and Cigna has announced a distribution of fresh, local produce for those who registered and actively participated in the 2023 Virtual Annual Health and Wellness Expo. Eligibility and Identification Requirements for Participants

Eligible recipients of the produce bags include Cigna Active employees, Cigna Retirees Under 65, and their dependents who registered and participated in the expo. Attendees are reminded to bring an ID for eligibility verification to receive their produce bag.

For United Healthcare members who registered and attended the expo, a separate produce distribution event will be organized by the GESC Health Insurance Board and United Healthcare, with dates to be announced shortly by the Board.
