V.I. Economic Development Authority Schedules Public Hearing and Board Meetings

The V.I. Economic Development Authority (VEDA) has announced a public hearing to be conducted by the V.I. Economic Development Commission (VEDC). The hearing is set to begin at 9:00 AM on Thursday, December 14, 2023.

The agenda for the VIEDC hearing includes reviewing application matters for businesses across various industries and categories, including financial, management, and investment consulting, family office services, manufacturing, and alternative energy

power generation. The businesses under consideration are located on St. Croix, St. Thomas, and St. John.

Following the public hearing, the VIEDA will hold decision meetings for the Enterprise Zone Commission and the Economic Development Park Corporation. Additionally, application and compliance matters for the VIEDC will be addressed.
