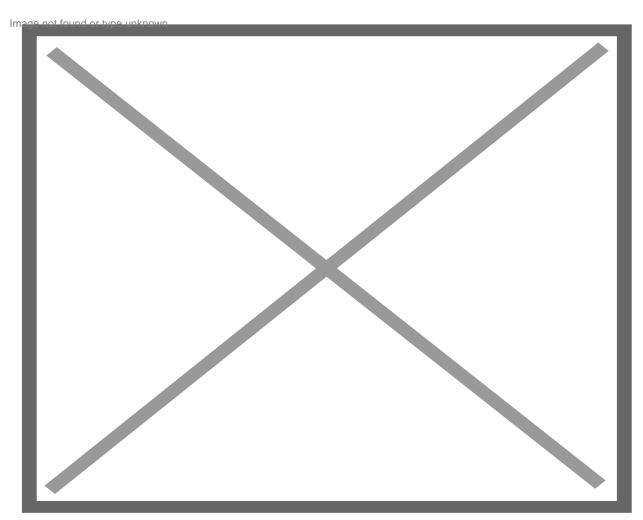
U.S. Virgin Islands Earns Three Distinct Honors at Caribbean Travel Awards
