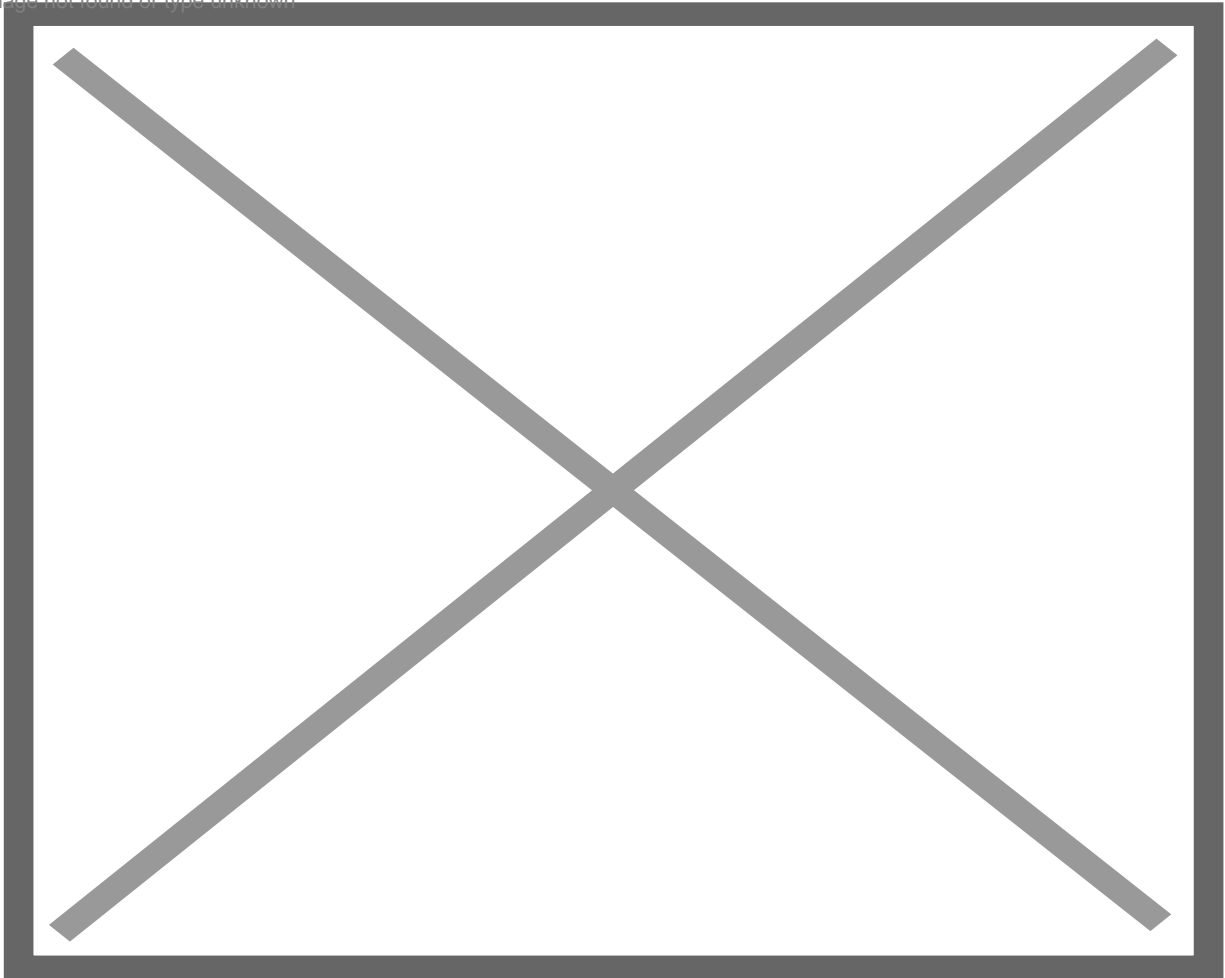
Bryan Nominates Judge Harold W.L. Willocks to V.I. Supreme Court
