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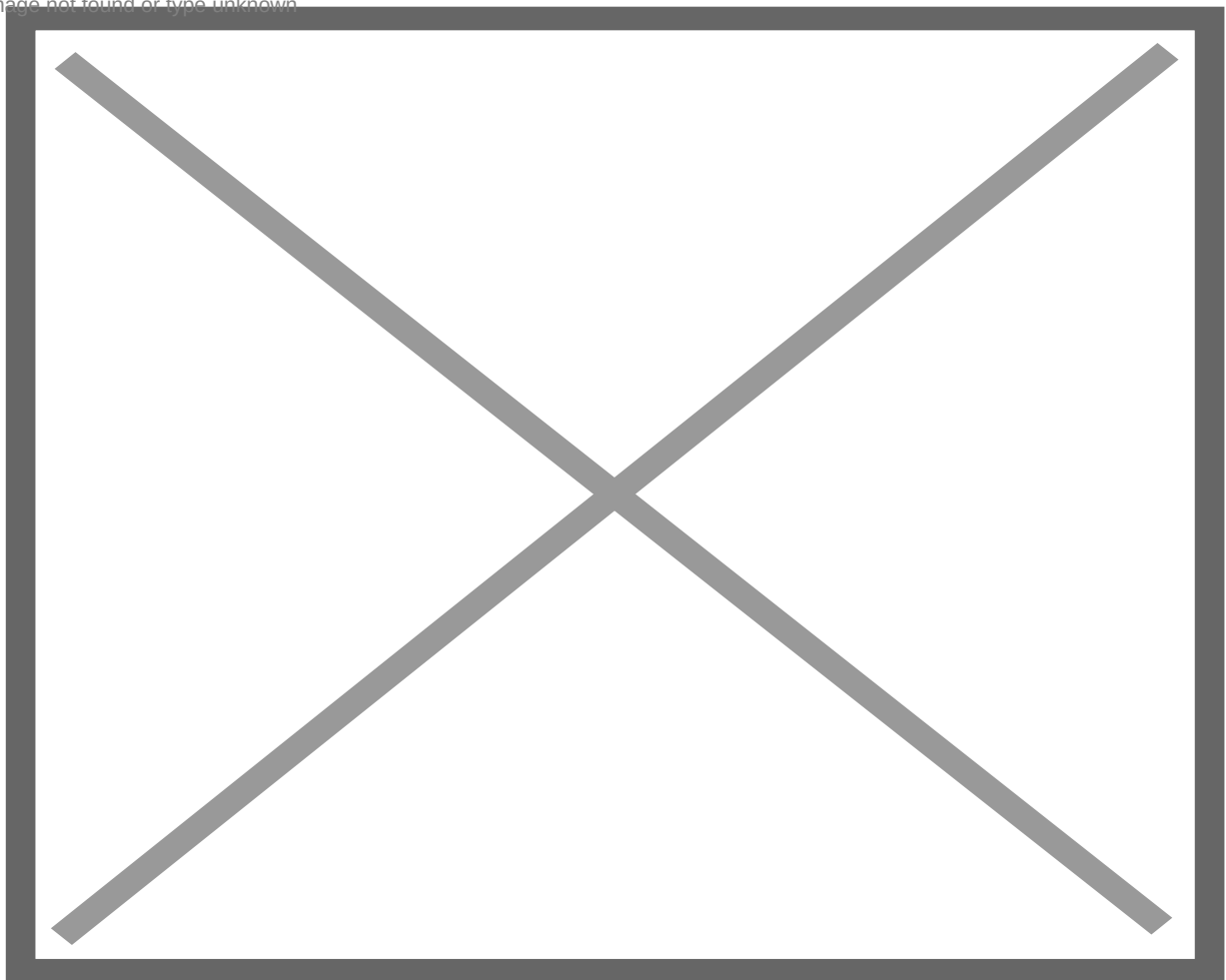
St. Croix Educational Complex Celebrates 'Muffins With Mom' With Aim of Strengthening Parent-student Bonds
