
Watch | AFT St. Croix President Refuses to Leave School Premises

St. Croix Superintendent of Schools, Carlos McGregor, on Friday called police to have American Federation of Teachers Local Chapter President, Rosa Soto-Thomas, removed from the premises of the Arthur A. Richards K-8 School, because he did not want her to be part of a meeting to update the staff on the reasons the school was closed today — and will probably be for some time. Mrs. Soto-Thomas decided she would not leave because, she said, as head of AFT on St. Croix she had a right to know the problems affecting her members. The meeting was held up for over an hour until Mr. McGregor decided to move forward with Mrs. Soto-Thomas present. Mr.

McGregor said he simply did not want Mrs. Soto-Thomas to be part of what he said was a staff meeting. Turns out (as you'll seen in an upcoming video), the information relayed did not warrant the level of opposition waged by Mr. McGregor.
