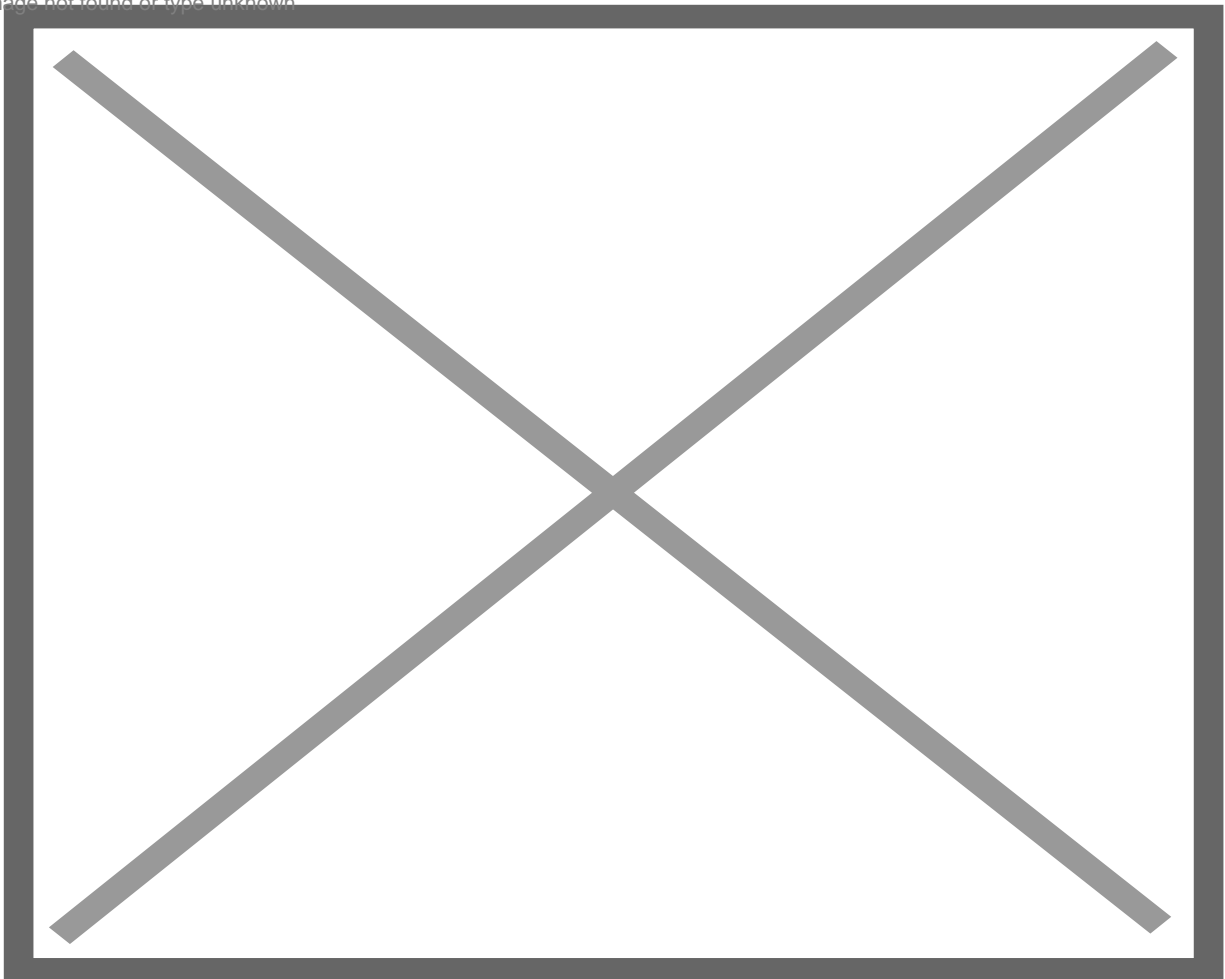
## Sharlene Belton-Gonzalez Appointed New Insular Superintendent for St. Croix District
