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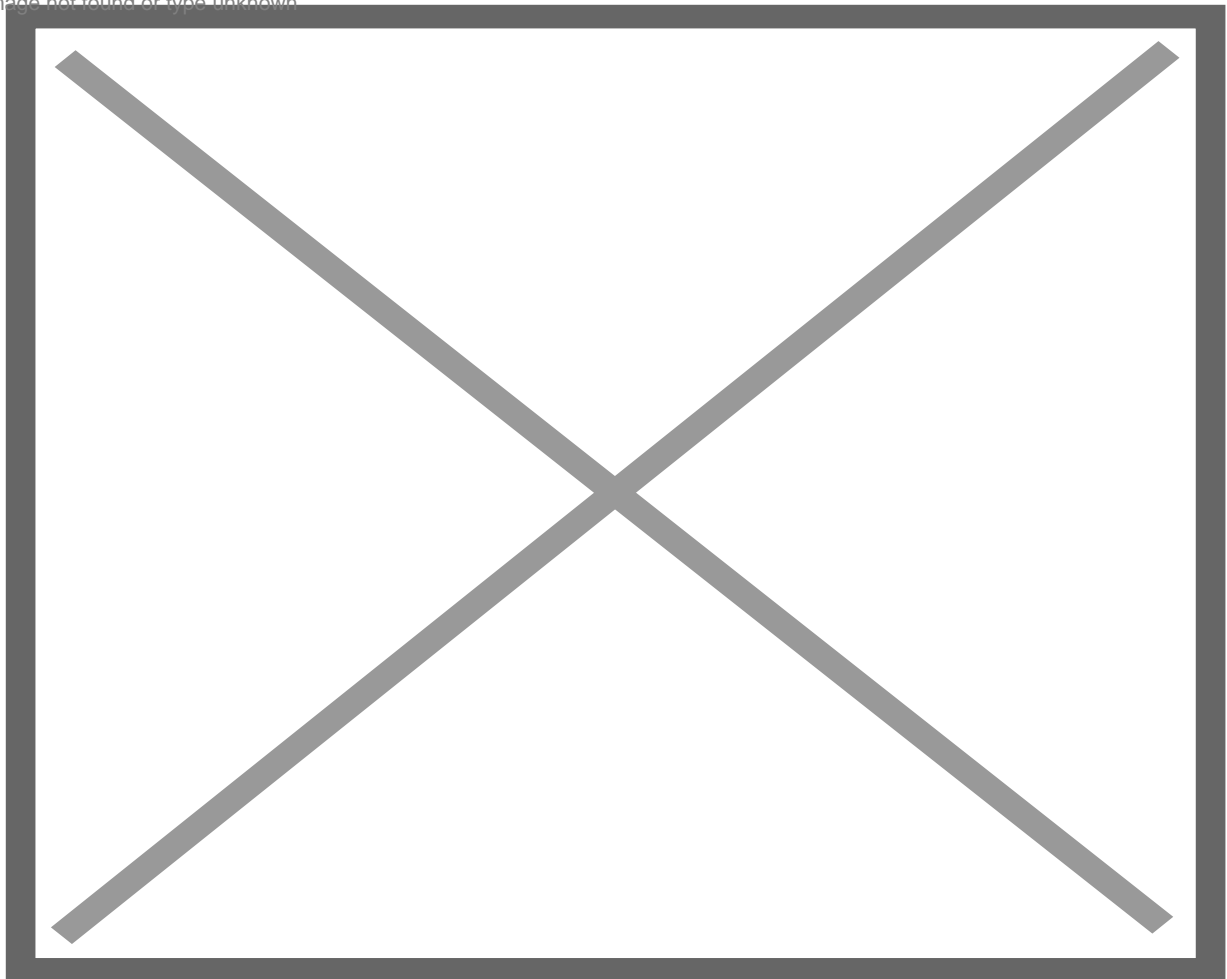
USVI Partners with LPGA as Official Caribbean Destination for FM Championship
