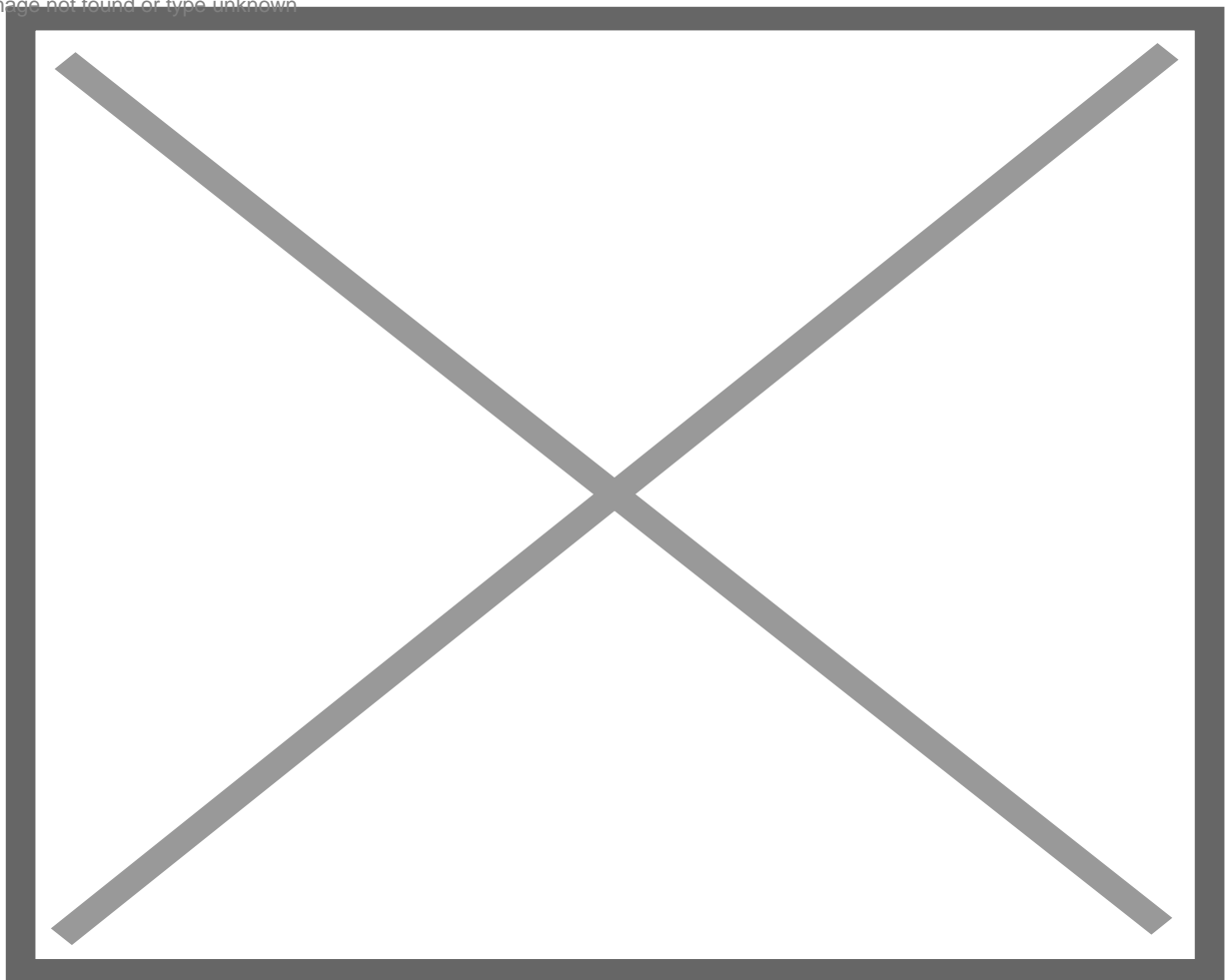
St. Croix Gears Up for Busy 2025 Cruise Ship Season with 98 Scheduled Calls
