
WAPA Governing Board Names New COO and CFO

The V.I. Water and Power Authority has appointed Lemuel Lavinier as chief operating officer of electric and Lorraine Kelly as chief financial officer. The appointments were approved during a special Governing Board meeting on December 6.

Lemuel Lavinier steps into the role of COO of electric with over 22 years of experience in power system operations, construction, and sustainable energy management, according to WAPA. He previously served as the superintendent of electric power for the city of Orangeburg Department
