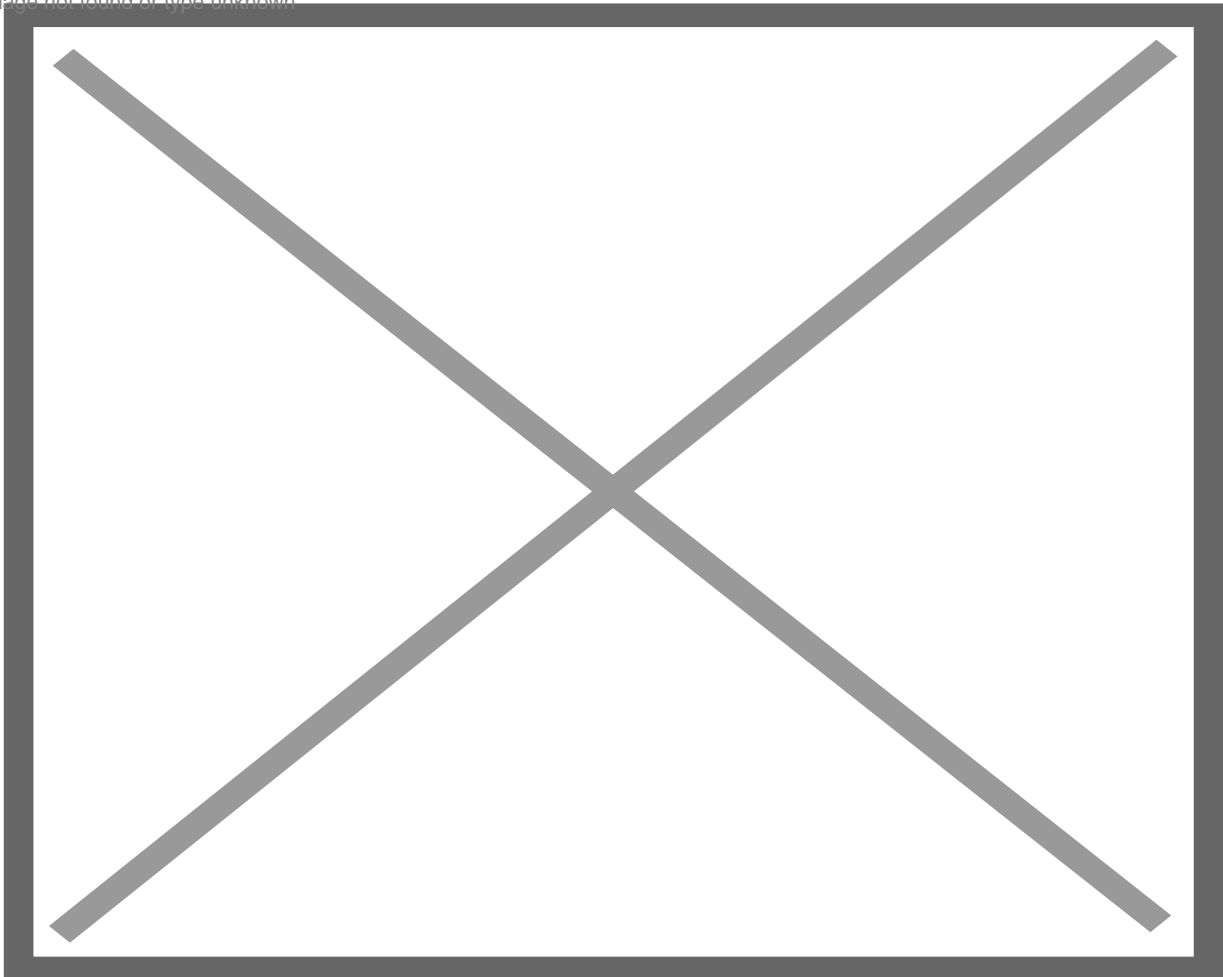
36th Legislature Leadership Announced: Senate President, Majority Leader, and Finance Chair Named Ahead of January 13 Swearing-In
