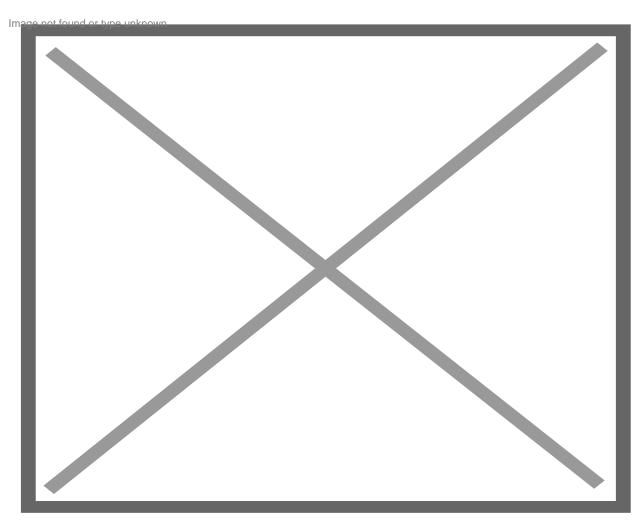
Banco Popular Breaks Ground on New Sunny Isles Branch in St. Croix
