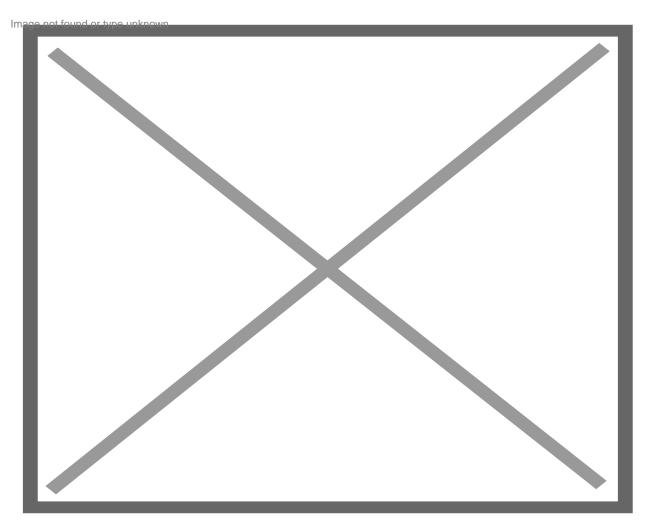
CBP Announces Reduction of Hours in St. Thomas-St. John District in Response to Covid-19
