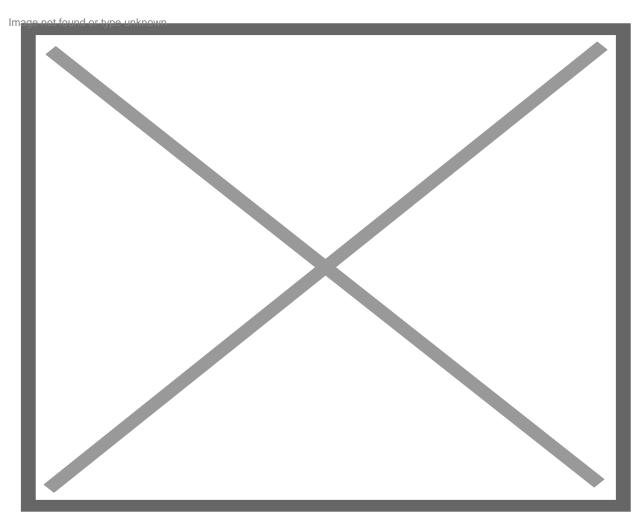
## **Church's Texas Chicken to Open St. Croix Location August 30**
