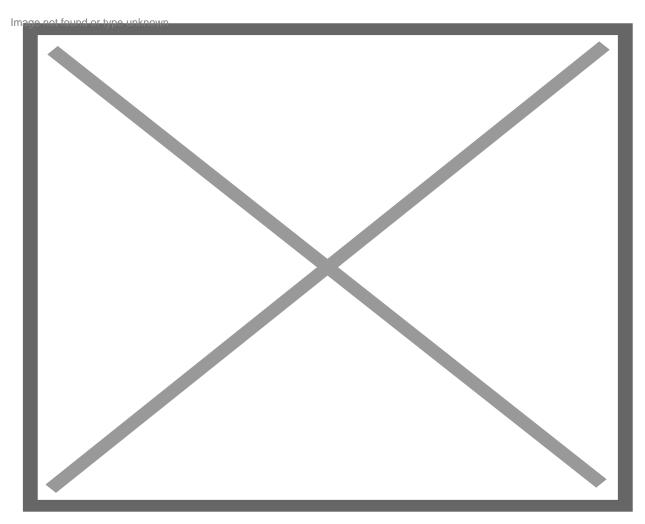
Tourism Launches Territory-Wide Recruitment for Hospitality Greeters and Entertainers

Additional requirements include a flexible schedule, a valid business license, and proof of full COVID-19 vaccination. Bilingual proficiency in both English and Spanish is preferred but not mandatory.

This effort is part of the Department's broader push to make a lasting impression on guests from the moment they arrive, blending informative support with cultural pride through music, conversation, and local flair.
