Petra Carbon George Launches Smart Money Kiddos Series With Kianna's Lemonade Goal

The materials also state that, as a mother, George views the series as a way to lead by example with her own children by showing that the methods and principles presented in the books are practical, effective, and achievable in real life.

The series is designed to teach the value of saving money, the importance of goal setting, and life skills including confidence, responsibility, and creativity. It is intended for children, families, and classroom settings.

According to the materials, each book also includes activities and key financial literacy vocabulary after the story to help children begin their financial learning journey.

Kianna's Lemonade Goal follows a young girl who loves playing soccer with her friends. Running fast and kicking hard makes her feel happy and strong. When their soccer ball goes flat, Kianna does not give up. Instead, she comes up with a plan to reach her goal.

The story is intended to show that teamwork, patience, and determination can turn small ideas into meaningful accomplishments.

The book is the first installment in the Smart Money Kiddos Series, with six additional books currently in development.

According to the materials, each title in the series is inspired by and named after one of George's children. The next release is expected to be Keyshun Counts His Coins.
