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## Nigy Boy to Make First St. Croix Appearance at Sunny Side Up's "Boots & Bottles"

After a week dominated by politics, Sunny Side Up offers a change of pace Sunday at Prosperity Farm, where Nigy Boy will make his St. Croix debut during a rodeo-themed day party featuring DJs, brunch, mimosas, photo backdrops and a real horse on site.
