St. Croix Man Arrested In Nebraska On Drug Possession Charges

A routine traffic stop on Interstate 80 in Lancaster, Nebraska has lead to the arrest of a well-known St. Croix bartender named Gibbs Bully, Lancaster sheriff Terry Wagner has revealed, first reported by [KETV](#).

Bully was stopped by Deputies when he improperly changed lanes, and for driving on the shoulder of Interstate 80 about 12:30 a.m.



Bully, driving a 2014 Ford Escape, gave officers consent to search his vehicle where they found 5.4 pounds of marijuana. Deputies also found a court receipt showing that he forfeited a large amount of money in Kansas on July 31st.

Bully is no stranger to the law: in March 2014, he was arrested by the Kansas Troopers for possessing 50 pounds of marijuana.

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
