Governor Mapp Announces 4 New Commissioners, Including Health And Human Services

Governor Kenneth Mapp has announced the appointments of four new commissioners to lead the departments of Health, Human Services, Property and Procurement, and Planning and Natural Resources.

The appointees are as follows:

2. Department of Health acting Commissioner ? Ms. Phyllis Wallace
3. Department of Human Services acting Commissioner ? Mr. Richard Lacombe

4. Department of Property and Procurement acting Commissioner ? Mrs. Cecilia Milliner-Emanuel

The Mapp administration says all appointees "will serve as acting commissioners until such time as all agencies and instrumentalities have been fully evaluated." The appointees will also be presented to the 31st Legislature for confirmation.

The Governor has yet to name a commissioner for the Department of Labor.
