GESC Gives March 31 Deadline For Retirees To Pay Plan F Coverage Balances

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The Government Employees Service Commission (GESC) Health Insurance Board of Trustees is requiring retirees who are primary members over age 65 and who have dependents also over the age of 65 to pay balances in full by March 31 on their Plan F option of coverage offered by the V.I. Government through United Healthcare.

The selection of the Plan F option meant that members agreed to the upgraded plan and the additional costs associated with it.

The Board said it issued a letter from the Group Health Insurance office to applicable retirees specifically addressing the arrangement of payments.
