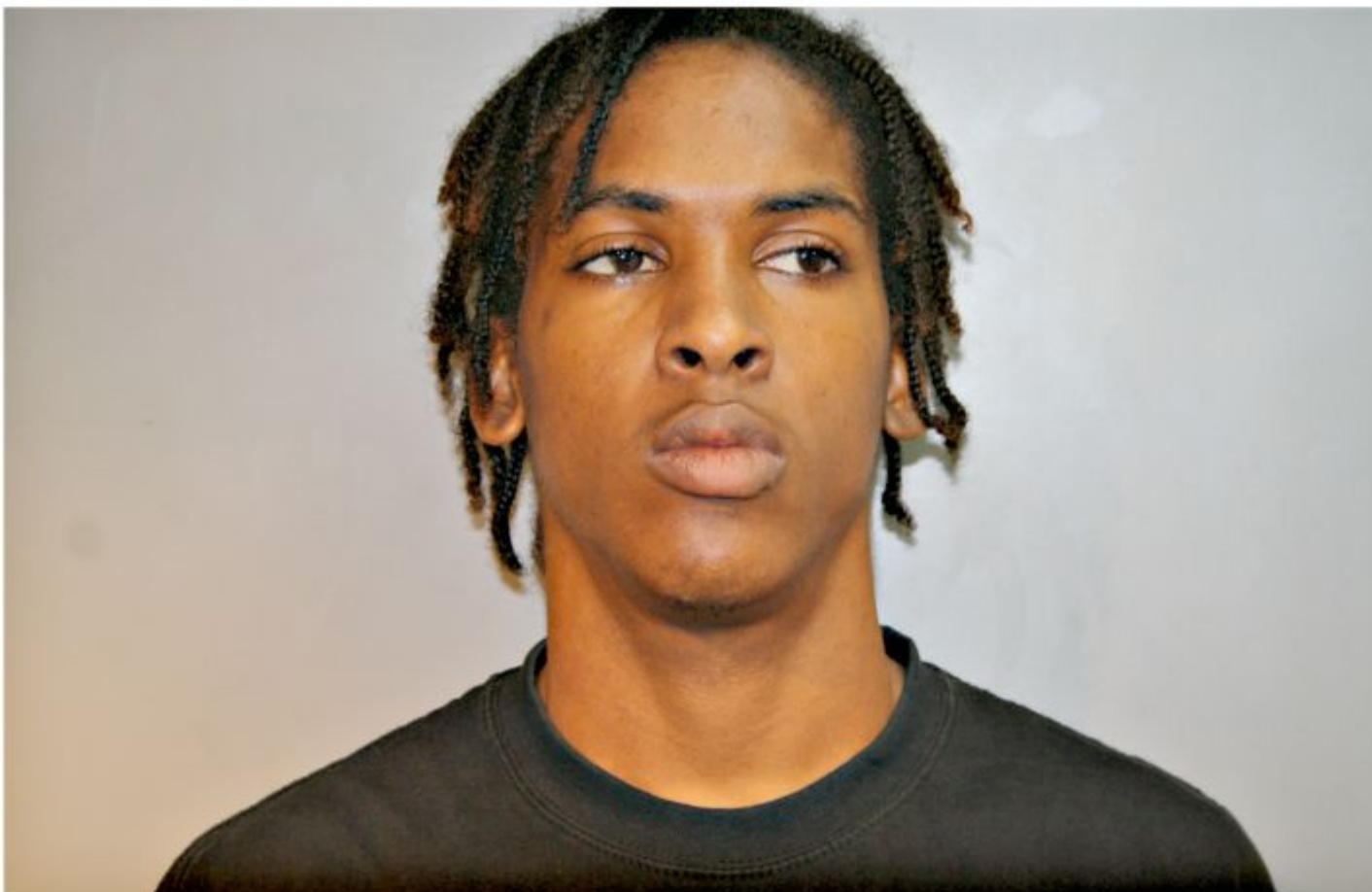
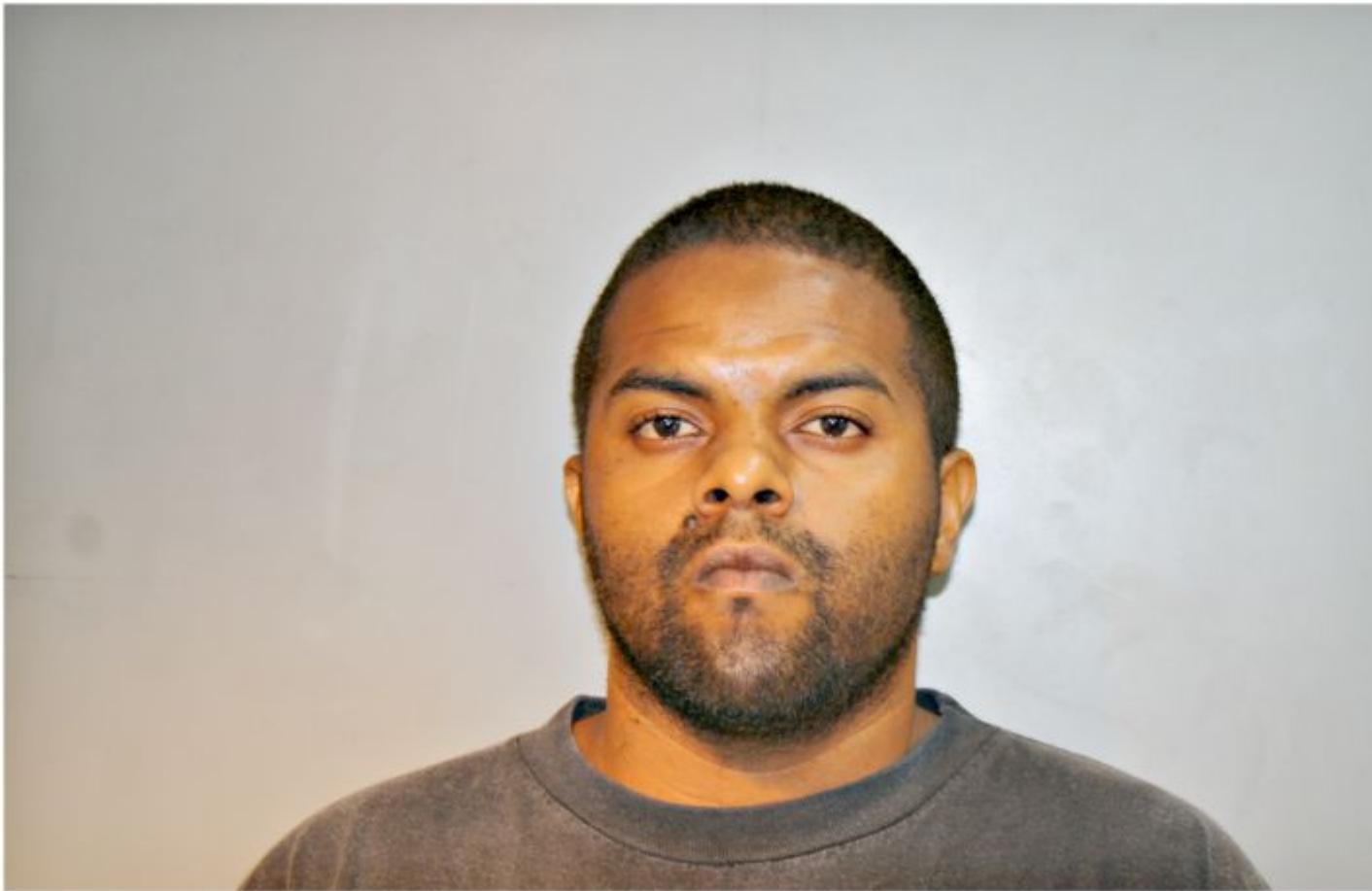
domestic dispute. Cruz was remanded to the Bureau of Corrections pending his advise-of-rights hearing.
