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ST. THOMAS -- Governor Kenneth Mapp has accepted the resignation of St. Thomas and Water Island Administrator, Lawrence Boschulte, a press release Government House issued late Monday made known.

Mr. Boschulte stated in a letter to Randolph Knight, the administration's chief of staff, that his experience was rewarding, although he gave no explanation as to why he gave up the job.
