
Banco Popular to End its Payroll Protection Program Loan Applications June 29

Popular announced today that they will accept applications from the Small Business Administration (SBA) Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) until 5:00 p.m. Monday, June 29. The United States Congress launched the second round of aid, which began on April 27, with a \$310 billion budget.
