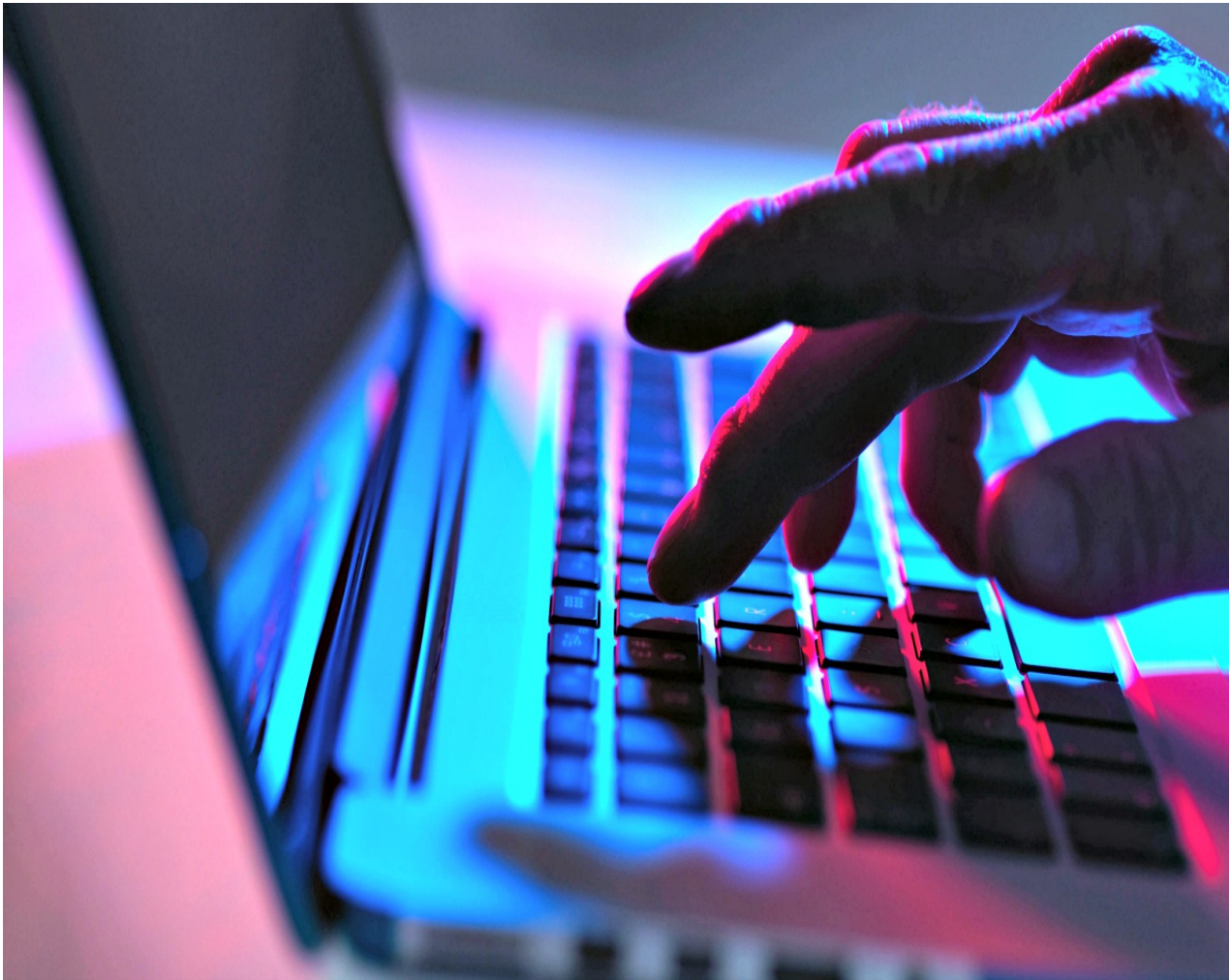

Man Sentenced To 57 Months In Prison For Possession Of Child Pornography

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ST CROIX -- Antonio Sanes-Carmona, 45, of St. Croix, was sentenced on Wednesday to 57 months in prison, five years of supervised release and a fine of \$1,000 for possession of child pornography, Acting United States Attorney Joycelyn Hewlett announced.

District Court Chief Judge Wilma A. Lewis also ordered Sanes-Carmona to pay a \$100 special assessment.

On December 21, 2016, Sanes-Carmona pleaded guilty to one count of possession of child pornography. According to the plea agreement filed in court, Sanes-Carmona admitted to possessing child pornography images that showed minor males and females

engaged in sexually explicit conduct with adults and other minors.

The case was investigated by Homeland Security Investigations. It was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Rhonda Williams-Henry.

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
