These Are The Free VINGN Hotspot Locations Territory-Wide

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In the wake of Hurricanes Irma and Maria, with cellular service still intermittent in many areas and with companies such as Viya, the territory's largest internet service provider, being badly damaged by the storms (most of Viya's customers are without service), the initiative by the Virgin Islands Next Generation Network (viNGN), as well as Viya, to install free WiFi hotspots in multiple locations around the islands have been a positive for the community.

In a release issued Sunday, viNGN included an updated list of its hotspot locations around the USVI. Find them below.

- Florence Williams Public Library (outside)
- Grove Place Fire Station
- Midre Cummings Ball Park/Fairgrounds in Frederiksted
- Sunny Isle
