SBA Opens Disaster Loan Outreach Center In St. Thomas

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ST. THOMAS -- The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) announced on Monday the opening of an SBA Disaster Loan Outreach Center (DLOC) at the Nisky Shopping Center in St. Thomas, on Tuesday. SBA staff remains in St. Thomas to assist survivors impacted by Hurricanes Irma and Maria, the SBA said.

SBA representatives at the DLOC can provide information about disaster loans, answer questions and assist in completing the SBA application, according to the release. The center is located as indicated below and will operate until further notice:
