The committee will continue planning to host the AOTG in Spring 2019. “The committee is fully committed to making the next AOTG a grand affair to remember,” said Loretta Lloyd, Afternoon on the Green Committee co-chair. “We look forward to returning to the green – fabulous dishes, prizes for our dedicated cooks, great entertainment and lots of fun for the children.”
