The company, which is celebrating 45 years of providing travel and entertainment options focused on L.G.B.T.Q. women, has not been to St. Croix since the early 1990s, according to information provided in the invite.

The women will be welcomed to St. Croix by Senator Janelle Sarauw, according to information provided in the invite. Ms. Sarauw is openly gay.
