
Office of the Lieutenant Governor Announces Virtual Information Sessions for Online Catalyst System

Lieutenant Governor Tregenza Roach is inviting the business community to attend the Division of Corporations and Trademarks' virtual information sessions on the online Catalyst system. Sessions are open to existing and new business owners, and service providers who assist businesses with filings to the Division of Corporations and Trademarks, Mr. Roach's office said.

The online Catalyst system is accessible 24 hours-a-day, seven days-a-week. It is used to create a user account and register business entities. Catalyst is also used to maintain the business entity status of active/in good standing to avoid administrative dissolution for failure to comply with the annual or biennial statutory requirements, according to the release.

The compliance feature provides business entities and trade name owners with email notifications informing them of past due and upcoming filings.
