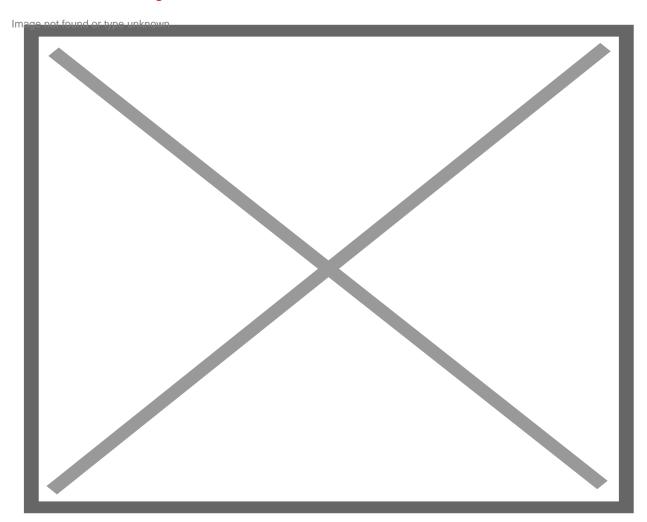
Community Care: Men of Rotary Mid-Isle Keep Road Verge Garden in Golden Rock Clean
