Potter Encouraging Property Owners To Submit Post Hurricane Form By July 28

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Lieutenant Governor Osbert Potter on Friday urged property owners who sustained hurricane damage and are submitting the “Request for Post Hurricane Irma & Maria Information” for the first time, to pay their property taxes by the due date of July 28, 2018 and no later than September 28, 2018 to avoid delinquency.

According to the release, if the Office of the Tax Assessor determines upon review of the information submitted that a change to the property owner’s 2018 valuation/bill is necessary, the bill will be adjusted and a credit will be issued on the next bill.

Property owners are asked to provide dated pictures and other supporting documents with the forms.
