Early Dismissal At Central High As Electrical Issues In Cafeteria Cause Fire

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ST. CROIX -- Effective immediately, the Department of Education has announced early dismissal of classes at St. Croix Central High School on Thursday, September 6 due to an electrical issue affecting the cafeteria and the campus's major wings.

Students have been reporting to their parents that the electrical issue caused a fire in the cafeteria.

An electrician is on-site assessing the situation and has determined a specialized part is needed from off-island in order to complete repairs. School bus service is being dispatched to transport students to their regular drop-off locations. Parents are asked to

pick up students from the school's campus.
