ST. THOMAS -- The Virgin Islands Police Department is seeking the community's assistance in locating a 16-year-old minor who was last seen on Jan 5 at the St. Thomas Behavioral Health Care Facility, which is a division of Seaview's Adolescent Unit, V.I.P.D. Public Information Officer Glen Dratte has announced.

The minor is Hilary Paris, a slim, light complexion female, according to the V.I.P.D. Hilary is said to weigh between 118-120lbs, and is approximately 5'4" tall with shoulder length hair.

Hilary left the Seaview facility at approximately 8:00 a.m. on January 5 and was last seen wearing grey jogger pants, a black sweater, and a red, yellow and green-knitted hat along with a possibly pink pair of crocs shoes.

The minor is known to frequent the Oswald Harris Court Housing Community and Estate Thomas residential area, according to police.
