Bryan Appoints Nelson, Rodriquez And Molloy To EDA Board

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The U.S.V.I.'s Economic Development Authority (EDA) announced Thursday that Governor Albert Bryan appointed three new members to the EDA Board of Directors: Dept. of Labor Commissioner Nominee Gary Molloy, Dept. of Agriculture Commissioner Nominee Positive Nelson, and Bryan administration Deputy Chief of Staff, Kevin Rodriquez.

In accordance with VI law, the new members -- along with those appointed already -- will serve at the pleasure of the governor. Mr. Bryan once led the E.D.A.

The E.D.A. is a semi-autonomous government organization responsible for promoting economic growth, job creation, and wealth generation in the U.S. Virgin Islands, America's Business Paradise.
