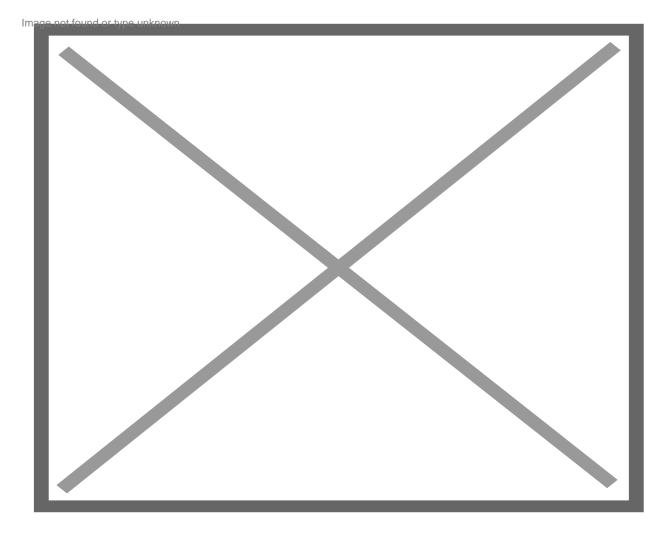
Limetree Bay to be Recognized for 2019 Safety Performance
