
## Woman Injured by Gunfire During Shooting Incident at Housing Community

ST. CROIX — A woman was injured by gunfire during a shooting incident at the David Hamilton Jackson Terrace housing community Friday night, V.I.P.D. spokesman Toby Derima has announced.

According to the V.I.P.D. news release, on Friday at about 9:21 p.m., the 911 Emergency Call Center dispatched officers to the housing community in reference to reports of shots fired with a possible victim. Officers traveled to the area and found community residents assisting an adult female who was apparently injured by a gunshot. The victim was transported to the Juan

Francisco Luis Hospital for treatment of a minor injury.

Witnesses reported seeing a vehicle, described as a Black Acura, leave the area after the shots were fired. Officers and crime scene investigators examined the scene and collected evidence in furtherance of the investigation, Mr. Derima said.
