Yacht Owner From Florida Allegedly Rapes His Employee During Taxi Ride From Red Hook to Yacht Haven Grande

ST. THOMAS — The owner of a yacht was arrested Saturday afternoon for allegedly raping one of his employees while they were on a taxi from Red Hook to Yacht Haven Grande, police spokesman Toby Derima has announced.

According to the news release, on Saturday at roughly 1:30 p.m., police arrested 67-year-old Hugh D. Fuller, Jr. of Boca Raton, Florida, and charged him with first-degree rape and unlawful sexual contact.

Mr. Derima said an investigation into this matter revealed that Fuller, the owner of a vessel, sexually assaulted a female steward of the vessel during a taxi ride from Red Hook to Yacht Haven Grande. The assault was reported to the vessel's captain, who subsequently called 911.

Unable to make bail of \$100,000, Fuller was turned over to the Bureau of Corrections pending his advisement hearing.
