
## Department of Human Services Reminding Food Stamp Customers to Keep Appointments

1. Keep scheduled appointments to help avoid interruption to your benefits.

2. Bring all necessary documents to your appointment so that your application can be processed quickly. Documents may include:

Proof of Identity Proof of citizenship. Social Security Card Proof of income Rent receipt or lease Utility bills Child support payment information W2 form, if self-employed Child-care receipts

3. Provide current address and telephone numbers.
