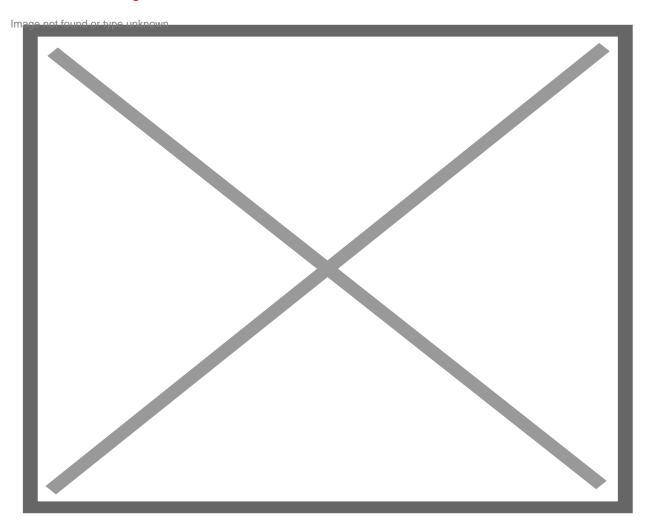
Latest Winners of \$100,00 and School-Based Personnel 'Vax-to-Win' Lotteries Announced

Vax-to-Win Lottery Winners in both the general and school-based offerings.

A V.I. Lottery official joined Governor Albert Bryan during Monday's Covid-19 press briefing to reveal the latest winners of the administration's "Vax-to-Win" lottery incentive, this time including the first set of winners of the special lottery for school-based personnel.

Last week winners (the week of August 6) were revealed to be <u>Ione Noel</u> on St. Croix, who won the \$100,000, and <u>Barbra Ortega</u> in the St. Thomas-St. John District, who won \$50,000, as she had only received one dose of a Covid-19 vaccine at the time of the drawing.

For the school-based personnel drawings, the St. Croix District winners were:

- 1. Joseph Auguste (St. Croix Educational Complex): \$25,000
- 2. Henry Awika (University of the Virgin Islands): \$10,000
- 3. Minerva Delauney (St. Croix Central High School) \$5,000

School-based personnel drawing winners in the St. Thomas-St. John District were:

- 1. Vernon Callwood (Charlotte Amalie High School): \$25,000
- 2. Eric Christian (University of the Virgin Islands) \$10,000
- 3. Eugene Farrell (Saints Peter & Paul High School) \$5,000

Latest Covid numbers
