
Crucian Beauty Janeisha John Brings Her Captivating Aura to the Cover and 8 Pages of New-York Based Ellements Magazine




Janeisha John, the St. Croix-born Virgin Islands model, television host and producer is the featured beauty on Ellements Magazine's Holiday Issue.


