
USVI Employers Reminded to Submit 2021 Injury and Illness Data by March 2

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The University of the Virgin Islands Safety In Paradise (SIP) Program is reminding employers that certain businesses are required to electronically submit the Injury and Illness Data for the Calendar Year 2021 by March 2, 2022.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) collects this information annually and began collecting Form 300A data on January 2, 2022, for the 2021 calendar year. Electronic submissions are required by establishments with 250 or more employees currently required to keep OSHA injury and illness records, and establishments with 20-249 employees classified in specific industries with historically high rates of occupational injuries and illnesses.
