Dept. of Health Discontinues Pop-Up Clinics Throughout Territory Effective March 31

The V.I. Dept. of Health announced Wednesday that its pop up clinic sites located at The Market and Farmer's Market on St. Croix and at Cost U Less on St. Thomas will be discontinued as of March 31.

The pop up on St. John at the V.I. Port Authority Gravel Lot will continue Wednesdays from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. until further notice.

Vaccines will be available at the Community Vaccine Centers on St. Thomas and St. Croix.

According to D.O.H., the remainder of this week (March 23 – 25) the Community Vaccine Center (CVC) on St. Croix will continue operations at the Nissan Center in La Grande Princesse, adjacent to the Honda Dealership and The Paint Shop, on the same side of the street as Food Town. Vaccines at this center are available to all age groups.

On March 28 the St. Croix CVC will move to the Charles Harwood Memorial Complex. At this new location the CVC will operate Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. and will continue to make vaccines and boosters available to all age groups. Because this new location is a smaller setting, appointments for vaccines/boosters are strongly encouraged, according to the release.
