Man Wanted For Vehicular Homicide in Georgia Arrested on St. Thomas

ST. THOMAS — A man wanted for vehicular homicide in the state of Georgia was arrested on Monday in St. Thomas, the V.I. Police Department has announced.

V.I.P.D. Director of Communications Glen Dratte reported that 36-year-old Terelle Malik Ross was taken into custody at 9:00a.m. Monday by the department's Criminal Investigation Bureau.

Along with the vehicular homicide warrant, Ross is also wanted for several other alleged

crimes.

Mr. Dratte said Ross was arrested, processed and remanded to the Bureau of Corrections pending his court appearance which is expected at the next scheduled advisement hearing on Wednesday.

No bail was set at time of publication, the police department said.

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
