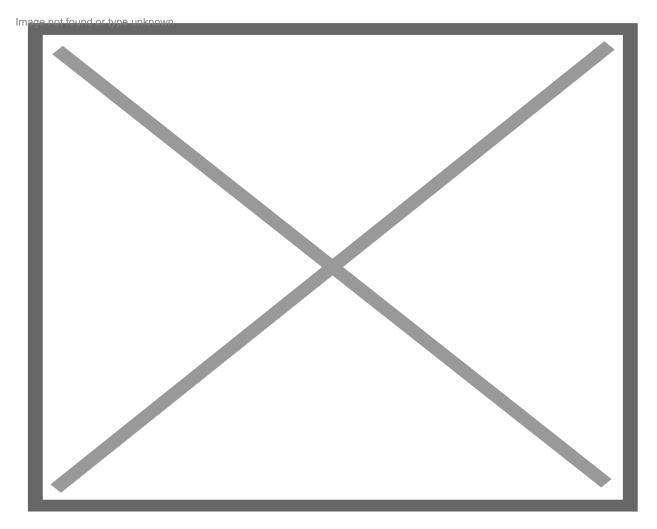
Photo Gallery: U.S. Air Force Conducts 'Forward Tiger' Joint Military Exercise on St. Croix With Caribbean Partners


