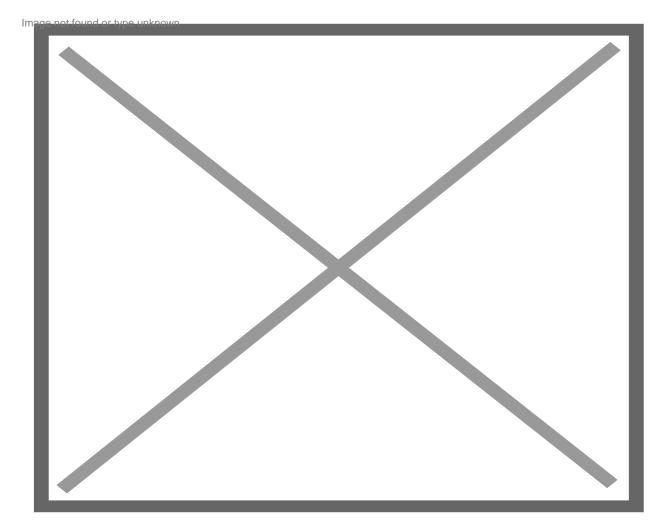
## My Brother's Workshop To Receive \$10K Donation from T-Mobile
